


# Q1 What school do you attend?\*


# Q2 What grade are you in this year?\*


Q3 What is your age?\*


# Q4 What is your gender?\*

**Q5** Please check the 5 most important issues you think **youth in our community** are facing today.\*






Q7 What school related activities do you participate in ? Check all that apply.






Q10 If yes, what limits you from participating in after-school or weekend activities? Check all that apply.
